



Dual Credit and Advanced Placement

COLLEGE CREDIT ONLINE

Students enrolled in dual credit (DC) courses earn high school and college credits simultaneously through Boise State University (BSU), College of Southern Idaho (CSI), North Idaho College (NIC) or Northwest Nazarene University (NNU). Credits can be transferred to most other universities.

To participate in dual credit courses, students must meet the eligibility requirements of the institution, which may include: minimum age, high school course completion, GPA, and/or parent permission. Students also must register with the respective university, pay the university fees, and complete the class to receive university credit.

Idaho Digital Learning Academy offers a total of 75 college credits through dual credit courses.

DID YOU KNOW?

- The \$75 IDLA fee is scholarshiped through a donation by the Albertsons Foundation's Go On! Campaign for all dual credit and AP courses.
- College registration fees: \$65/credit.

- You must be registered by a school counselor.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

Students enrolled in AP courses complete college-level coursework and prepare for the AP exam. Some AP courses require both semesters to receive the college credit. The second semester of each AP course includes test preparation. The AP exam is optional, and is administered at the local school. Contact your site coordinators to make arrangements to take the AP exam.

Many universities award college credit or advanced standing based on AP test scores. Contact the individual universities to inquire about their policies.

All IDLA Advanced Placement courses have passed the College Board Audit.
