

What is the registration deadline?

IDLA has set its course and registration deadlines to best accommodate all districts throughout the state. Though our schedule may not mirror all individual districts, the local school policy will be the guide when registering students, so long as this window does not exceed IDLA deadlines. (If parents/students call our office directly, they should be routed to their local Site Coordinator for registration as they will know local policy and are ultimately responsible for registering students)

How much do courses cost?

\$75 for the 2010-2011 school year. There are fee waivers for Advanced Placement and Dual Credit classes as other fees may apply (ie: concurrent credits, AP exam, textbooks). Fee waivers are also available for ISAT/Conceptual courses.

When is the refund deadline?

3 weeks after the start of our 16 wk courses and 2 weeks after the start of our 9 & 12 wk sessions. (Deadlines are posted on our homepage calendar)

What classes can I take?

IDLA relies upon the local Site Coordinator to properly place students in classes with regard to age restriction (AP/DC), prerequisites and sessions. With the submission of registrations, through the school, IDLA will place students according to this request and students/parents should seek their guidance to determine the classes the district will allow.

How much do dual credit courses cost?

The universities charge \$65 per credit. Additional material, such as textbooks, varies from class to class. To see the needed resources, access the course catalog. Many districts will pay for these resources so students should clarify their financial expectations before enrolling.

What courses do you offer?

All of our courses are available to Idaho students currently enrolled through a public school (if they are private or home school, refer them to the Regional Coordinator for assistance enrolling them). For conflicts with course lengths/subjects, students should refer to their local Site Coordinator/Counselor/Administrator to clarify local policies regarding IDLA classes.

Can I continue IDLA classes even though I'm moving out of state?

If the student is transferring schools, please have the Regional Coordinator contact the Site Coordinator/Local Admin to arrange the movement of this student. There are questions here which could affect this particular class: Is the student coming back? Who will proctor the final? etc. (Though these instances are minimal, they are usually addressed on a case-by-case basis)

Does IDLA offer scholarships?

Yes, scholarships are determined by local school policy and submitted through their local Site Coordinator. They should contact him/her to seek their availability.
