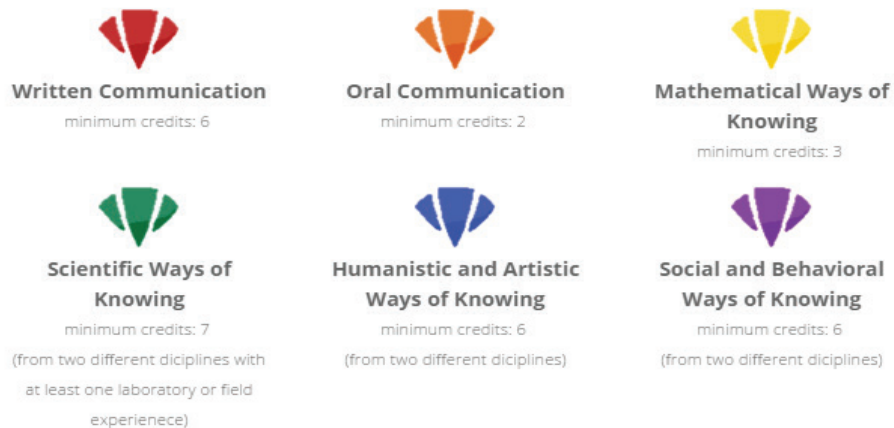


GEM Courses
