

What to Expect From an Idaho Digital Learning Instructor

- The instructor will adhere to **the Code of Ethics** for Idaho Professional Educators
- Timely documentation, including **end of unit progress (grade) reports** and final grades
- The instructor will advertise and be available for office hour(s) at regular intervals throughout the week
- The instructor will ensure instructional modifications required by a special education student's Individual Education Plan (IEP) or 504, are being met
- The instructor will document all relevant communication entries—including important phone calls, emails, chats, and IM's to students, parents and site coordinators
- The instructor will post at least two (2) announcements in the course each week
- A **culture of academic writing** will be modeled and encouraged. Regular class **assignments will be graded within 72 hours** (3 days); longer course assignments, projects, course papers, graded within 96 hours (4 days)
- **At least one assignment** will receive personal, **specific and detailed feedback**
- The instructor will participate in all asynchronous communication activities (discussion boards, wikis, blogs, and voice boards)
- The instructor will make a welcome call home within the first 2 weeks of class.
- The instructor will communicate with an adult if a student's grade falls below 70% on an even numbered progress reports
- The instructor will encourage students to redo assignments
- The instructor accepts for the entire length of the course, **all late assignments for at least 50% of value**. This includes alternatives to discussion boards in cases where the student has not participated in a timely manner (see course syllabus for details)
